Parmly Billings Library is moving to a new electronic catalog. In November, we will join the Montana Shared

**Catalog**, a state-wide cooperative project with over one hundred of Montana's libraries. Through this consortium, borrowers will receive increased shared professional expertise.

When the Library catalog goes live, you may still reserve books, videos or audiobooks, as well as download electronic audiobooks directly to your computer. And, with your permission, we can email notices to you.

Because these modifications involve the entire computer network at the Library, NO public internet stations will be available on Tuesday, November 10 only. Regular internet access will resume on Thursday, November 12, after the Veterans Day holiday.


