

TED, a nonprofit, began (in 1984) as a conference bringing together people from the worlds of technology, entertainment and design. Since then it's become a clearinghouse that offers free knowledge and inspiration from the world's most inspired thinkers, and also a community of curious souls who engage with ideas and each other.

Riveting talks by remarkable people—and you can see it as it happens! The folks at TED have granted Parmly Billings Library a license to broadcast live from the TED conference on Wednesday, February 29, 2012. We will show the full slate of fascinating speakers talking about ideas that matter, from science to the arts. Stop in for part or all of the day. We'll start at 9:30 am and run through 7:45 pm on the 3rd Floor.
