- **Greg Kemmis, 2176 Skokie Place, Billings, Montana**, in reference to 1C1, stated he represented Landon’s Legacy Foundation, and urged the Council to approve the master plan for the Poly Vista Park and develop a special needs facility at the park. He provided an explanation of the Miracleleague.com playground surface and equipment. He discussed Landon’s Legacy Foundation and the child the foundation was named after.
