- Kevin Ploehn: AVIATION – overview of accomplishments, statistics, numbers and types of revenues, operating revenue, expenses, capital, and AIP grant funded projects. Review of terminal expansion project. MET - accomplishments, statistics, revenues, operating budget, and FTA assisted purchases.

- David Watterson: overview of revenues and expenses, central telephone services, and expenditures. Review of new staff online training program.
- Joy: website redesign? Watterson: 20 person website committee to correct ADA Compliance, spelling, training, etc. Online payments, police reports, online form availability for crime prevention, and job opportunities.

- Cromley: Sherriff's office services? Watterson: house all communications for safety, jail module, 24-7 support.
- Ronning: Committee identified other City websites they would like to see? Watterson: would like input from Council and staff. Also, looking at Civics Plus newest sites to find best features.
