

Public Hearings:

Item #1: City Zone Change #869 – 412 Hallowell Lane – A zone change request from Public (P) to Residential 6,000 (R-60) on a 7,500 parcel of land described as a 50 foot by 150 foot lot in the Northeast corner of Lot 3 in Section 9, T1S, R26E, Tax ID #D01626, Lean 2, LLP, owner and Marshal Phil, BlueLine Engineering agent.

The City Council has designated **Monday, November 22, 2010**, at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers as the time and place to hear testimony for or against the above-mentioned item. Before taking any action on an application for a **special review use**, the City Council shall first consider the findings and recommendations of the City Zoning Commission. In no case shall the City Council approve a special review use other than the one advertised. The City Council shall take one of the following actions on these Special Review requests: 1) approve the application; 2) conditionally approve the application; 3) deny the application; 4) allow withdrawal of the application; or 5) delay the application for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days.

The Council will hear all persons wishing to speak relative to the proposed special review uses.
