Public Hearings:

Item #1: City Zone Change #872 – 1910 and 1918 Shiloh Road – County BUFSA - A zone change request from Residential 7,000 (R-70) to Residential professional (RP) on two properties described as Lot 1A and Lot 1B of Rush Acreage Tracts Subdivision a 54,153 square foot parcel of land, Tax IDs C02242 and A30733; Yellowstone County, owner and Daniel L Schwartz, Chief Deputy County Attorney, agent.

The City Council has designated **Monday, February 28, 2011**, at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers as the time and place to hear testimony for or against the above-mentioned items. As provided in Montana Code Annotated, Section 76-2-305(2) (1999), in the event of a protest petition against such **zone change** signed by the owners of twenty-five (25) percent or more of: (1) the area of the lots included in any proposed change; or (2) those lots one hundred fifty (150) feet from a lot included in a proposed change, such proposed amendment shall not become effective except by the favorable vote of two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) of the present and voting members of the City Council. The protest petition must be received in the Planning Department office by 5:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding the first reading of the amendment by the City Council. The Zoning Commission and City Council will hear all persons wishing to speak relative to the proposed zone changes. Testimony regarding the above mentioned items may also be submitted in writing to the Planning Division, 510 North Broadway, Parmlly Library 4th Floor, Billings, MT 59101 or to the Mayor and City Council, P.O. Box 1178, Billings, MT 59103.
