The City Council has designated **Monday, June 25, 2012**, at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers as the time and place to hear testimony for or against the special review and zone changes.

As provided in Montana Code Annotated, Section 76-2-305(2) (1999), in the event of a protest petition against such **zone change** signed by the owners of twenty-five (25) percent or more of: (1) the area of the lots included in any proposed change; or (2) those lots one hundred fifty (150) feet from a lot included in a proposed change, such proposed amendment shall not become effective except by the favorable vote of two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) of the present and voting members of the City Council. The protest petition must be received in the Planning Department office by 5:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding the first reading of the amendment (June 22, 2012) by the City Council.

The Zoning Commission and City Council will hear all persons wishing to speak relative to the proposed zone change. Testimony regarding the above mentioned items may also be submitted in writing to the Planning Division, 510 North Broadway, Parmlly Library 4th Floor, Billings, MT 59101 or to the Mayor and City Council, P.O. Box 1178, Billings, MT 59103.

Additional information on any of these items is available in the Planning and Community Services Office. Public hearings are accessible to individuals with physical disabilities. Special arrangements for participation in the public hearings by individuals with hearing, speech, or vision impairment may be made upon request at least three days prior to the hearing.
