BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

 AMENDMENT. Pursuant to Billings Municipal Code, Section 1.16.030 and the State Law, Billings Municipal Code, Section 1.16.030 Ward Boundaries is hereby amended by removing from the following designated Ward the following described real property:

Ward I: A tract of land situated in the SW1/4 of Section 27, T.1S., R.26E., Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana, more particularly described as:

Tract 81A of Amended Tracts 29-33, 47-53, 62-67, 78-85, 90-94 of Certificate of Survey No. 2165, Recorded January 26, 1983, Under Document No. 1253064, Records of Yellowstone County, Montana, annexed under Resolution No. 02-17819, Recorded April 18, 2002, Under Document No. 3173017, Records of Yellowstone County, Montana; Containing 13.823 gross and net acres, more or less.
