Downtown Billings Bicycle Parking Program

Bicycle parking is an important element to downtown Billings' transportation system. Providing parking for bicycles near employment, retail and cultural destinations ensures reasonable options for this non-motorized mode of transportation. Bicycle parking is good for business, increases ridership, offers an alternative to driving, and decreases the demand for automobile parking.

How do I apply for bicycle parking?

It is very simple and inexpensive to get bike parking in the public right-up-way. The first step is to submit this application to the City of Billings Planning Division. The Planning Division, Public Works Engineering and the Montana Department of Transportation (State routes) will review the application and notify the applicant if the location is approved. If approved, the City of Billings and the Downtown Billings Alliance will install the bike parking facility in accordance to the Downtown and Right of Way Bicycle Parking Guidelines and Bike Rack Master Plan Locations Map.
