RESOLUTION NO.04-18141

A RESOLUTION LEVYING AND ASSESSING STORM SEWER FEES FOR PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF BILLINGS, PROVIDING FOR NOTICE, HEARING AND FINAL ADOPTION

WHEREAS, the Billings, Montana City Code did establish the rate table for Storm Sewer assessments; and

WHEREAS, extension of these charges have been made on individual properties to be assessed annually.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. ANNUAL STORM SEWER FEE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005. That for the purpose of defraying the cost of upgrading, repairing and maintaining the City Storm Sewer System for the fiscal year 2005, upon all lots or portions of lots as identified in the city's property tax record files an annual storm sewer fee is assessed.
2. DISPOSITIONS OF COLLECTIONS. Monies collected from taxes shall be paid into the Storm Sewer Fund of Billings, Montana.
3. NOTICE OF HEARING. On Monday, **June 14, 2004**, at 6:30 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be considered on the agenda in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, Billings, Montana, the City Council will hear objections to the adoption of this resolution. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice thereof twice, at least five (5) days prior to the hearing, in the Billings Times.
4. CERTIFICATION. The City Clerk is hereby directed upon final passage and approval of this resolution to certify a copy thereof to the City Administrator of the City of Billings, Montana, who shall certify a copy to the Yellowstone County Clerk and a copy to the Yellowstone County Assessor.
5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall be effective 30 days following the second reading of the ordinance amending Section 22-804 of the Billings, Montana, City Code.
