

ORDINANCE NO. 97- 5044

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, BILLINGS, MONTANA, BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 24-1102 OF SAID CODE; PROVIDING THAT PARKING ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS SHALL EITHER POSSESS THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR OR OWN REAL PROPERTY IN THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

Section 1. That the Billings, Montana, City Code be amended by revising Section 24-1102, to read as follows:

"Sec. 24-1102. Composition, appointment, term.

The Parking Advisory Board shall be composed of nine (9) members who shall possess the qualifications for the office of mayor and or own real property located within the Central Business District. They shall be appointed from the city at large by the mayor with the consent of the city council. Members shall serve for staggered terms of four (4) years each, provided that the Mayor shall limit the terms of the first members as follows: two (2) members' term will expire at the end of the first year; two (2) members' term will expire at the end of the second year; two (2) members' term will expire at the end of the third year; and three (3) members' term will expire at the end of the fourth year."

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after second reading and final adoption as provided by law.

Section 3. REPEALER. All resolutions, ordinances, and sections of the City Code inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance which may be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
