Dear Mayor and members of the Billings City Council,

The Rimrock Neighborhoods Task Force, RNTF, recommends approval of the amendments to the City of Billings Nuisance Code as detailed and recommended in the City staff recommendation to Council scheduled for Public Hearing and First Reading of Ordinance on 12/10/18 business meeting.
